Title: Replacement

Passage: Ephesians 4:22-24

Pray for Our Church (EFCLA)

- Pray for Revival. Pray that there would be more people form revival prayer groups. Through group prayer, people would experience life renewal, caring and healing. And through prayer, the Lord would add more saved people to us.
- Pray for Children's Congregation. Pray that the Lord would use Director Ruth, Deacon Frank, Deacon Tony, Deacon, Charlie, and the Sunday School teachers/helpers to lead the children into knowing Jesus, following Jesus, praying to Jesus, and serving Jesus.

PRAY FOR THE WORLD
