

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for Happiness Group.** Pray for the Loving and the Living Water Happiness groups. Pray for those people who open their houses for Happiness Group. Please pray that the BESTs would come back.
- Pray for New Believers. There are eight people including six children going
 to be baptized on Easter. Pray that the Lord would strengthen their faith to
 be the salt and light in this secular world.
