SERMON NOTES

Title: Momentum Passage: Romans 1:16 & 5:1-5

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for Happiness Group.** Pray that the Holy Spirit would work in the hearts of the ten plus BESTs, so that the BESTs would open their hearts to accept Jesus Christ as their personal savior.
- **Pray for Missionaries.** Pray for those missionaries sponsored by our church. Pray that the Lord would keep them safe, and the Lord would empower them to preach the gospel boldly to the local people.
- **Pray for the Sick.** Pray for those who are sick or infected. Pray that the Lord would heal them and restore their health.

PRAY FOR THE WORLD
