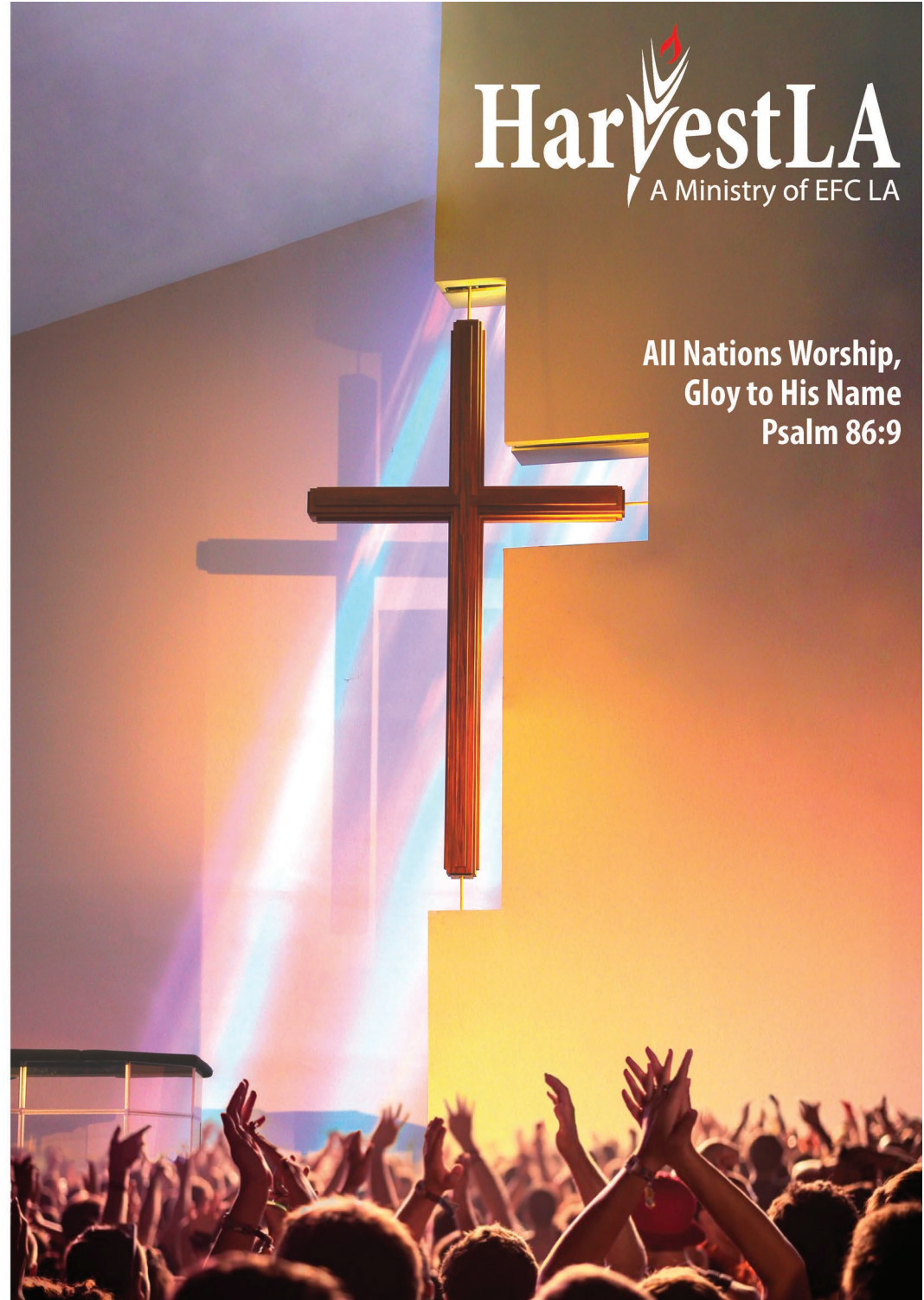

## SERMON NOTES

Title: **How Shall They Hear?**

Passage: Romans 10:13-15

## PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for EFCLA.** Beginning in April is the church's annual mission month. May the Holy Spirit empower brothers and sisters to be willing to step out of their comfort zone, not only to listen to the Word but also to do it. May the Lord make more people eager for the gospel and willing to spread the gospel, live out the gospel, and learn from Jesus to pay the price for the gospel, no matter what form it takes to achieve the goal of witnessing for the Lord Jesus. May the Lord Jesus grant power so that brothers and sisters will not only have the motivation to change, but also have the ability to change, and be molded by the Lord step by step so that God's church will be full of power and saved people.
- **Pray for the ongoing work of evangelism.** Pray for the Happiness Groups and D2B: Please pray for the co-workers involved in the Happiness Groups. Pray that God would use their ice breakers, songs, testimonies, messages and companionship to touch the hearts of the BEST and lead them to Jesus Christ. Pray for the brothers and sisters who are in D2B. Pray that God would use them to use the D2B materials to break through the strong strongholds in the hearts and lead them to know Jesus.
