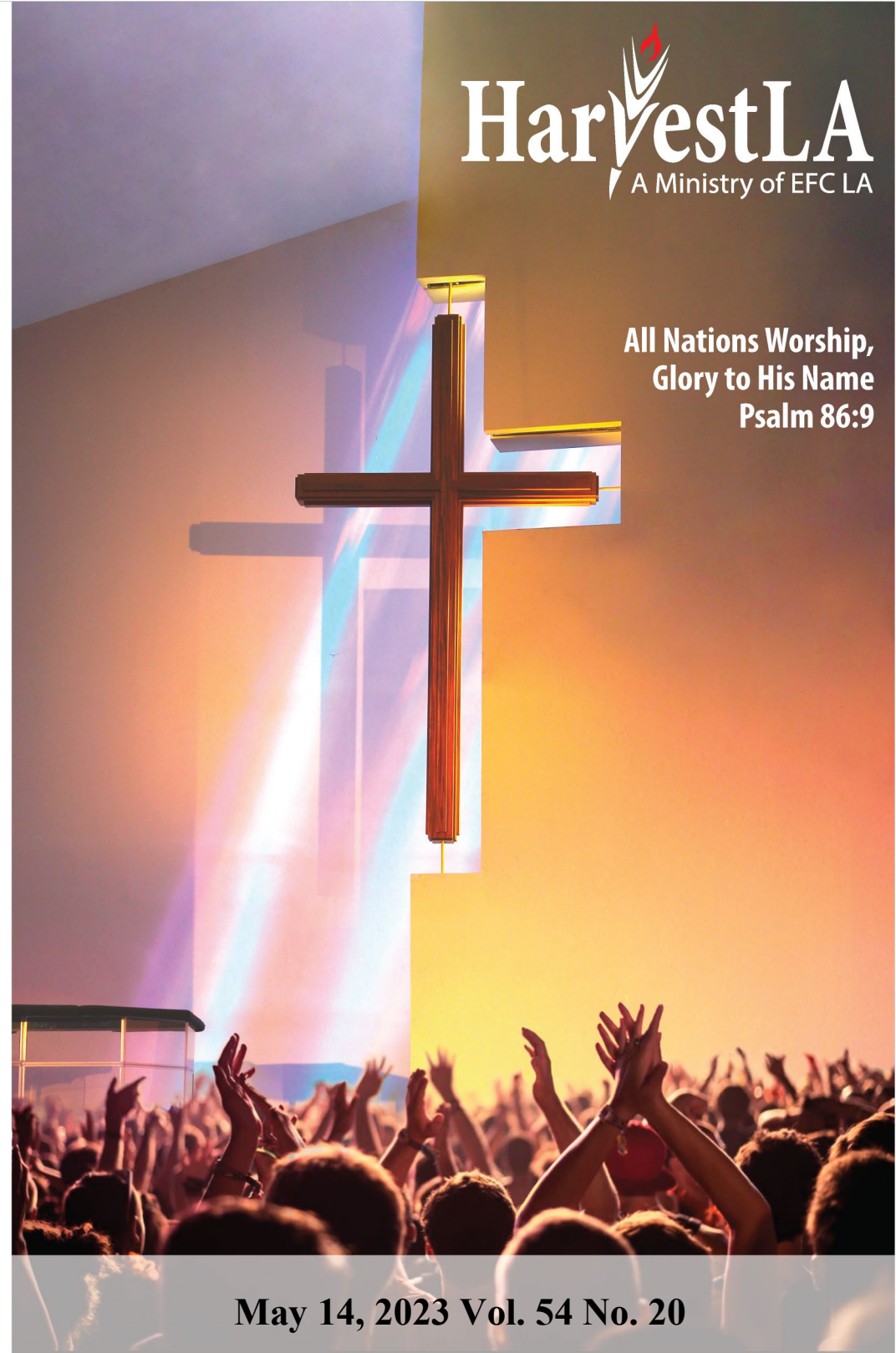

SERMON NOTES

Title: **The rescue plan of three women**

Passage: **Exodus 2:1-10**

Preface: We may not all be parents, but we must all be children. What kind of parents and children do we want to be?

1. Jochebed’s Faith

3. The compassion of Pharaoh’s daughter
