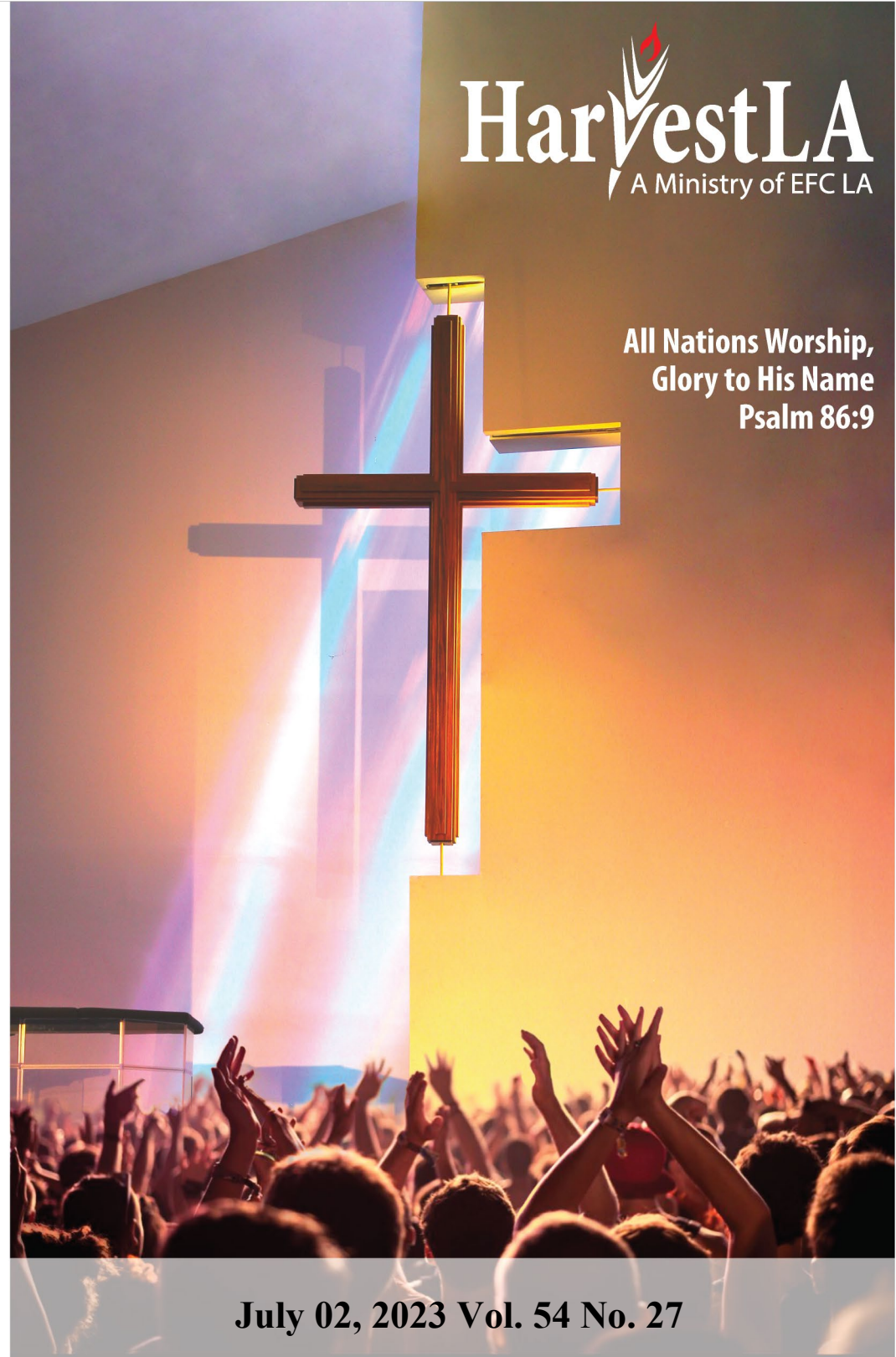

SERMON NOTES

Title: Moving from Unrest to Rest

Passage: Judges 21:25, Ruth 4:16-17

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for Summer Short Term Mission Trips.** (7/2-8 Taiwan Taichung Caring Church, 7/22-29 Taiwan West Coast, 7/30-8/4 El Cajon). May God keep their bodies healthy and fill them with a spirit of unity as they witness to the local students about the Lord Jesus. Pray that God will move the students to accept Jesus Christ as their Savior
- **Pray for the church.** Pray that God would encourage brothers and sisters to have quiet time with the Lord daily, that they would regularly spend time in reading His word and praying so that their lives may be transformed, and as a result, they would bear spiritual fruits as a witness of God.
