

SERMON NOTES

Title: Cultural Canvases: Dragons, Diversity, and the Divine

Passage: Acts 17:26-27

Pray for Our Church (EFCLA)

- Pray for Internet Media. Pray that brothers and sisters will be stirred up
 again in their zeal for the Lord, commit themselves to prayer, and experience God's presence and power. Everyone is encouraged to participate in
 morning prayer meetings, Wednesday prayer meetings (online and in-person), and RPG group prayer. Let church revival begin with prayer.
