SERMON NOTES

Title: The Unexpected Kingdom Builder

Passage: Nehemiah 1:1-11

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- Praying for the Church's ministry plans for 2025. Next year marks the 55th anniversary of our Church. We pray that the Lord will enable all the brothers and sisters in the congregation to understand His will. Through a collective reception of His guidance, may the church be empowered for breakthrough expansion in evangelism and community care.
