**Title:** Faithfulness of God

**Passage:** Hosea 2:19-20

I will betroth you to Me forever; Yes, I will betroth you to Me,  
In righteousness and justice, In lovingkindness and mercy;  
I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness, and you shall know the Lord.

## PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)
