

## SERMON NOTES

Title: Feet to Head-Dust to Glory

Passage: Luke 7:47

Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven--as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little.

## PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for Equipping Ministries.** Pray for our children's and adult Sunday school teachers. Pray also for discipline and baptismal classes' teachers. Pray that the Lord would use them to build up the brothers and sister in truth, and to prepare them ready to witness for Him and glorify Him.
