

Title: " Divine Communion"(Source of Resilience)

Passage: Mark 14:26-42

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for New Believers.** On Easter Sunday, 21 brothers and sisters were baptized. May God strengthen their faith and help them follow the Lord steadfastly. Pray that God will inspire them to join fellowship groups, take equipping courses, and develop a habit of Bible reading and prayer.
