

## SERMON NOTES

Title: The Extravagance of God

Passage: John 2:1-11

## PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for the nomination of the elders and deacons of the church.** The church will nominate a new batch of elders and deacons at the congregational meeting in October. Pray that the Holy Spirit can inspire and guide new elders and deacons to participate in the service of the church. Let them have "great faith and be filled with the Holy Spirit". - **Pray for our church.** We pray that God will inspire brothers and sisters to have a longing and seeking heart for God, to know the Lord more deeply through spiritual reading of the Bible and prayer.
