

SERMON NOTES

Title: Bound for Glory

Passage: Romans 1:16-17

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for the October 12th Anniversary Celebration and the October 19th Church Member Meeting.** Pray that the whole church may gather together to worship God, count His blessings, and receive new vision. Pray that the church meeting's budget and the voting for new elders proceed smoothly, that brothers and sisters participate actively, come to know the church better, and grow in their sense of belonging.
- **Pray for the Sunday School programs from September to November.** "Why Believe – Faith Q&A", "Overview of the New Testament (Part 2)", "Discipleship School (Part 2)", and "7A Positive Parenting Course". May the Lord use these courses to help our brothers and sisters be firmly rooted in the truth and live out their faith in daily life. We also pray that the Lord would move more brothers and sisters to participate in these classes, so that Sunday School may become a vessel for church revival and spiritual growth.
- **Pray for the Happiness Outreach Small Groups.** The church's Happiness Groups for this fall have already begun. Please pray for the members of these groups, asking God to give them the same mindset and purpose, united in advancing the gospel.
