SERMON NOTES

Title: Two Kingdoms

Passage: Matthew 6:16-24

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for the church staff and leaders .** Please lift up the pastors, zone pastors, elders, deacons, advisors, small group leaders, and all the coworkers. We ask God to grant them wisdom to establish healthy boundaries in both ministry and daily life, so that they may serve in love and be renewed through true rest.
- **Pray for EFCLA's vision for 2026.** Renewal, strengthening, and expansion. May the church be renewed by the gospel, strengthened in grace, and see God's kingdom expanded. May this vision be communicated and advanced through the nourishment of the pulpit, the daily reception of God's Word in personal devotion, and the sharing of life and faith within small groups. Unite the church in purpose and obedience, and lead it to bear lasting fruit for God's glory.
