SERMON NOTES

Title: The Good "Enough" Mother

Passage: 2 Corinthians 12:9

My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. I will all the more gladly boast in my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

- GOODNESS in the Bible
- Good enough mother: Sufficiently Stable, Able to Repair, Allowing Frustration, Nurturing the True Self
- Mothers Are Guides
- See Your Mother Through God's Eyes
- In God's Love and Grace, forgive and accept Your Mother
- Choose to Honor her Sacrifice and Effort
- Our "imperfection" is precisely the crack through which God's grace enters our family.

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for wisdom, strength, strategy, talent, and discernment to be granted to pastors and ministry coworkers.** In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, we break all curses of the enemy upon pastors, and may the precious blood of Jesus cover them abundantly.
