Title: God's Mosaic Masterpiece

Passage: Psalm 51:17

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCH (EFCLA)

- **Pray for the younger generation.** We pray that God will raise up the younger generation in culture flooded with online lust, hookup culture, and moral relativism, grant our youth sharp discernment. May they reject the waves of nihilism and complacency, choosing instead to be the modern-day "set-apart Nazirites" who pursue holiness!
